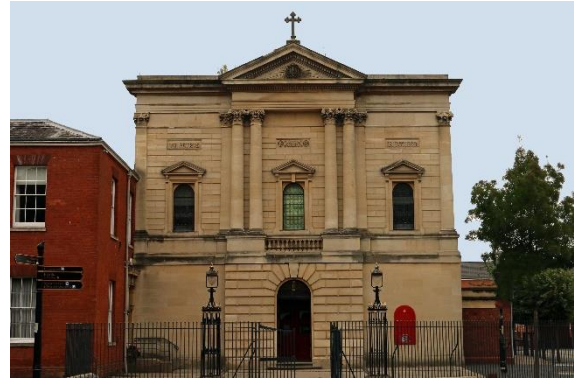


SSG Autumn Assembly

This year we gather in Worcester for the Autumn Assembly. For those able to be in Worcester on Friday evening, we will begin with a visit to Worcester Cathedral for Choral Evensong at 5.30 pm, followed by dinner at a nearby restaurant for 7.30 pm.

On Saturday, we will meet at St George's Parish Centre. St George's is a church with an exciting history. Its organ was installed in 1885, the same year that the English composer Edward Elgar became church organist there. The 'Elgar' organ is still in the church and we hope to have an opportunity to visit the organ loft during our visit.

What better place then, to learn something more about Edward Elgar, the compositions he wrote for St George's and the organ that he played there? We are delighted that Alan Smith has agreed to share with us the story of Elgar and St George's.

The Annual James Crichton Memorial Lecture entitled '*Foundations of 20th Century Liturgical Reform and Future Perspectives*' will be delivered by Fr Paul Gunter OSB, Secretary of the Department for Christian Life and Worship.
